

Starting from August 10, 2017 (9:00am), the SIS system will approve students by auto-balloting. You have to check your class selection result soon after the suspension period (i.e. August 10, 2017 (2:30pm)) and if you are not approved in taking the class you have selected, you should choose another available class in SIS until you are given a place in a class.

You can change your class freely during the add/drop period, but you should check your class selection result periodically. You are required to attend lessons in the original CAES class until your request for change of groups has been approved.
