 must apply for a HKSAR student visa for the purpose of education. It is the responsibility of individual students to
 make appropriate visa arrangement before they come to Hong Kong.
- The whole processing time can be up to 8-10 weeks upon receipt of a complete set of application documents sent by courier/registered mail (the actual processing time could be longer for individual cases, especially if your set of documents are incomplete).
