

- Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Laws (BA&LLB)

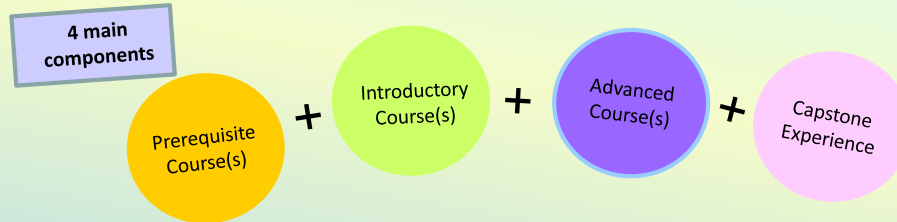

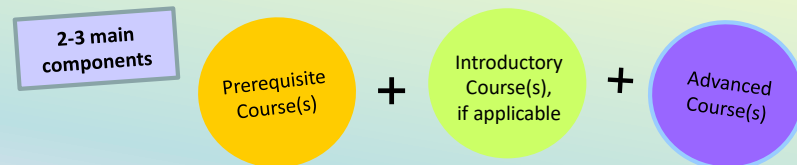

*The normal study load of an academic year is **60 credits**.
Students can take between **24-36 credits** in Semester 1 and Semester 2.*
