

The Korean Studies Programme at the University of Hong Kong

provides a multi-faceted and interdisciplinary approach to the study of Korean language and culture. Major and Minor students in the Programme not only study the Korean language but also learn about the country's history, culture, and society, and will develop a comprehensive understanding of Korea in a global context.

This exhibition is based on final-year student projects from the Korean Studies Research Seminar. From January to May 2023, students conducted individualized research projects related to Korea, drawing their academic learning from their experience at the University of Hong Kong.
