Arts Faculty Grants for Joint PhD Programmes

In September 2012, the Faculty of Arts established the Arts Faculty Grants for Joint PhD Programmes to support research postgraduate students who are enrolled in a Joint PhD Programme. The grants support students in undertaking studies and research activities in the partner institution overseas. The grants shall be awarded with effect from the academic year 2012-13 under the following regulations:

1. The grants shall be known as the Arts Faculty Grants for Joint PhD Programmes.
2. The grants shall be awarded to research postgraduate students in the Faculty of Arts who are enrolled in a Joint PhD Programme with The University of Hong Kong as the home institution.
3. The grants shall be of the value of HK\$20,000 each.
4. The grants shall be awarded on the basis of (i) the student's academic standing, and (ii) the value of the proposed trip to the student's study.
5. The number of awards in any year shall be determined by the Higher Arts Degrees Committee.
6. The purpose of the grants is to subsidize students' travel expenses and living expenses overseas, including but not limited to return airfare, lodging and local public transport, etc.
7. Eligible students can only receive the grants once during their normative study period.
8. The grants can be held concurrently with any other awards including a postgraduate scholarship.

Administrative Arrangements

1. Applications from eligible students are considered on a continuous basis in each academic year.
2. The award of the grants shall be determined by the Higher Arts Degrees Committee. The Committee reserves the right not to make any award in any year.
3. The Secretary of the Higher Arts Degrees Committee shall inform the Finance and Enterprises Office and the Secretary of the Board of Academic Awards of the name(s) of the grants recipient(s).
