[^] Students can count suitable courses taken in Sciences Po to fulfil the requirements of the Humanities focus. However, they are required to make up for the credit shortfall by taking the same number of credits from courses offered by any programme at HKU. In other words, the total number of credits required for graduation at HKU remains 150 credits.

^{*} Students who did not study Chinese language during their secondary education and have not reached the required proficiency level for the Chinese language enhancement course “CART9001. Practical Chinese for Arts Students (6 credits)” may take a course in either Chinese language or Chinese culture offered by the Chinese Language Centre of the School of Chinese in lieu.

2. Students can choose courses from one of the following Arts disciplines (except for language-learning courses, e.g., “KORE1001. Korean I.1”) as Humanities focus:

 - (c) Chinese History and Culture#;
 - (d) Chinese Language and Literature#;
 - (e) Comparative Literature;
 - (f) English Studies;
 - (g) Gender Studies;
 - (h) General Linguistics;
 - (i) Global and Area Studies;
 - (j) History;
 - (k) Hong Kong Studies;
 - (l) Japanese Studies;
 - (m) Korean Studies;
 - (n) Music;
 - (o) Philosophy; and
 - (p) Translation#

Enrollment conditions of the relevant prerequisite(s), if any, are applicable to this Dual Degree. Students may also be required to take additional course(s) to fulfil the pre-requisite(s) or co-requisite(s) of a course that they intend to take. Please click [here](#) for details.

3. Double-counting of courses for fulfilling more than a major and/or a minor at HKU is not allowed. In addition, students should complete at least 50% of the course requirements of their declared major/minor at HKU (i.e., the maximum credits can be transferred to a major is 36; that to a minor is 18). If they plan to fulfil the remaining requirements with the relevant free electives completed at Sciences Po, they should refer to [Useful Forms](#) for the guidelines and procedures of applying credit transfer.
4. Language minors (e.g., Arabic, French, German, Italian, Japanese Language, Portuguese, Spanish, Swedish and Thai) at HKU require students to complete 6 language progression courses spanned in 3 years while the Minor in Korean Studies only includes 4 language progression courses. Prior language proficiency will be required for students of this Dual Degree to complete a minor in language. A placement test will be arranged. Please click [here](#) for details.
